Applicants must hold at least a **Second-Class Lower Division (2:2) LLB Degree** or its equivalent from an accredited university, and must have passed the following core subjects:

- i. Contract Law I & II
- ii. Constitutional Law I & II
- iii. Law of Tort I & II
- iv. Criminal Law I & II
- v. Land Law/Immovable Property I & II
- vi. Equity & Trust I & II

Note: Applicants from the University of The Gambia must have a minimum AQPR of 3.00, with at least a pass in all of the above core courses. Transcripts must be sent directly from the Office of the Registrar to: admissions@gls.gm
